Registration:

We encourage you to register online through our website at www.villagedancearts.org. Click on the button "online registration / create account / log in." You may also register with the paper form by mailing or emailing it to the studio. The form is available in this packet and also online.

Returning students will receive a class schedule with teacher recommendations highlighted for them specifically. Please use this as a guide for registering.

Royal Academy of Dance Examinations:

Ballet students have the opportunity of working towards a Royal Academy of Dance (RAD) graded examination at the Primary level and above. Primary level students must take two classes per week. Grade One level and above require the student to take all technique classes offered per week at their level. All ballet students are highly encouraged to take modern dance classes to supplement their ballet technique. Students studying at a higher level or considering a career in dance may elect to study for vocational exams. Vocational candidates must have consistent attendance in their technique classes three to five times per week. For students considering taking a vocational exam, parent-teacher conferences will be scheduled before winter break to assess if the student is prepared to participate this year.

Recitals:

Steppin' Out X - April 21, 2024 / Ballet TBA - June 22, 2024 Mandatory dress rehearsals are April 18 for Steppin' Out X and June 20 for the ballet. Rehearsals and performances are at Citrus College in Glendora.

Dress Code:

Registration Fee

Annual fee due at first trimester \$ 20

Accepted forms of payment are cash, checks, Visa, MasterCard and Discover. All fees must be paid in advance. Trimester discounts are only available at the beginning of each trimester. Please write your child's name on your check.

You may create an account at villagedancearts.org and make your payments online.

Returned check fee: \$35.00. A late fee of \$10 will be applied for payments received after the 15th of the month.

Tuition fees do not include recitals, costumes, workshops, extra exam classes, mock exams or RAD exam fees.

Students are encouraged to make up any missed classes. Make-up classes must be taken in the same session of the missed class.

No refunds or credits will be issued for missed classes.

If your child is not continuing in a class, is adding a class, or his/her enrollment otherwise changes, please notify the office at least one week in advance of the next billing cycle. Failure to do so may result in additional fees.

Family discounts:

Siblings registered for up to 6 hours will be counted as one student. Siblings registered for more than 6 total hours per week will receive a 10% discount on each student's tuition. Siblings who are enrolled in Dance To Your Own Tune will be charged per student per class rather than per hour.

Studio Policies 2023-2024

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Tuition: Tuition is based on a 10-month year and is divided into three sessions:

Fall – August 28 to December 17 Winter – January 2 to March 24 Spring – March 25 to June 22

Payments are due in advance of each session. Summer fees are charged separately.

- Students taking two or more lessons per week have the option of making monthly installments which are due the beginning of each month. Students taking one class per week pay the full session fee. Note that the monthly installment remains the same each month regardless of holidays so that in some months there may be five weeks or there may be two or three.
- There are no refunds or credits for missed classes. In the event that your teacher needs to cancel, a make-up class will be scheduled.
- Tuition fees do not include recitals, costumes, workshops, extra exam classes, mock exams, Royal Academy of Dance exam fees, or master classes.
- All fees must be paid in advance. Session discounts are available only at the beginning of each session.
- A \$10.00 late fee will be charged 15 days after due date.
- Family discount 10% after the first 6 classes.
- Make-up classes must be taken within the same session of the missed class.
- \$35.00 fee on all returned checks. Please write your child's name on your check.

Registration and Schedules: Your initial enrollment will automatically carry over from trimester to trimester. If you are dropping or changing classes at any time, please notify us as soon as possible so that we ay adjust your account accordingly.

Attire: Appropriate attire must be worn to all classes. (See dress code information.) Hair for ballet classes must be worn in a neat bun. Short hair should be pulled away from the face.

Attendance: Punctual and consistent attendance is expected of all students. If your child is not continuing, please notify the office promptly. Failure to do so may result in additional fees.

Parking: Parking is available on First Street, Harvard Avenue and College Avenue. There is no public parking on Harvard Place (upper studio). All parking spaces on Harvard Place are private and may not be used.

Ballet shoes must be full-sole.

Please do not purchase ballet shoes from Target or Payless.

These shoes impede students from learning the correct usage of the feet.

Character shoes may be purchased through VDA.

Ballet: Hair must be in a bun for every ballet class. Short hair must be pulled away from the face. Students will be sent out of class to fix their hair appropriately. Parents, please ensure your dancer is prepared for class. Bobby pins and nets are available in the office for purchase. No jewelry, warmups, shorts, or rolled-up tights are allowed in ballet class. Dress code skirts are only allowed at the Primary and Advanced levels.

Jazz: Leotard for girls and white t-shirt for boys, black jazz shorts or pants, and black jazz shoes. Tan jazz shoes required for Intermediate Teen and Advanced jazz.

Tap: Leotard for girls and white t-shirt for boys, black dance shorts/pants, and full-sole tap shoes. No jeans or street clothes.

Modern: Black leotard for girls and black tank top for boys, black leggings or jazz shorts, no shoes.

Tumbling: Leotards, dance shorts, tank tops, or t-shirts, no shoes.

Hip Hop: Dance pants, tank tops, t-shirts. Clean sneakers.

Musical Theater: Leotards, tights or jazz pants, jazz shoes or musical theater character shoes.

Adult Classes: Comfortable clothes to move in, including leotards, dance pants, tank tops, or t-shirts. Ballet or tap shoes as appropriate.
